



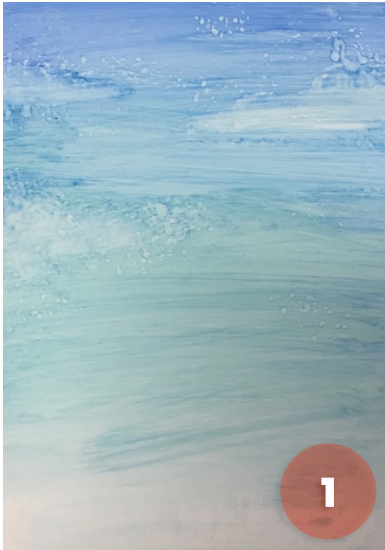
Lesson Plan – Prairie Sky Dragonfly

Create some beautiful buzz with this uniquely layered mixed media art panel.

SUPPLIES

- Marabu Alcohol Inks, Rainbow Additive and Extender
- Opaque white film, mounting film (Grafix)
- Dragonflies printed on clear laser copier film
- Double-sided tape, rubbing alcohol, brushes
- Board, spray bottle, paper towel, craft knife



Tape some opaque white film to cover the board. Drip alcohol inks in blues and greens along the upper right edge, then swipe the colors across with a paper towel dipped in rubbing alcohol. Allow colors to fade naturally toward the bottom, then remove spots of color with alcohol to create clouds. Flick alcohol from a stiff brush for interesting effects.



To create grasses, streak alcohol inks in earth tones using upward strokes from the bottom of the panel. Use a narrow brush to pull the inks out into stalks. Alternate with ink and rubbing alcohol to brush in more details.



Trim the dragonfly out of the film. Brush it with inks and the Rainbow Additive on the back. Use double-tack mounting film to adhere it in place on your background panel.
