



## Lesson Plan – Psychedelic Textures

Surround your alcohol ink design with texture.

### SUPPLIES

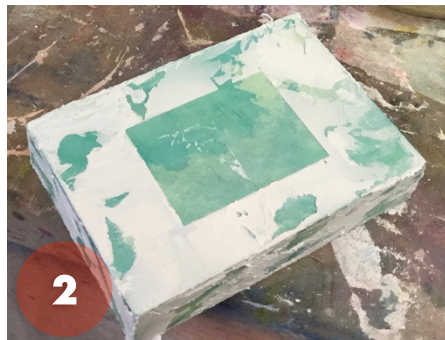
- Marabu Alcohol Inks and Art Sprays
- Porcelain & Glas Painter pen
- Artist-Tac film, opaque white film (Grafix)
- Wood panel, gesso, molding paste
- Painter's tape, rubbing alcohol, brushes
- Eye dropper, palette knife, finishing spray
- Wax paper, sandpaper



Prep the wood panel with gesso and let dry. Spray all sides with a variety of Art Spray colors. When dry, seal with a light acrylic finishing spray.



Randomly drop alcohol inks on opaque white film, alternating with rubbing alcohol in an eye dropper. Use a brush to add dots and lines. When dry, write a sentiment with a white Porcelain & Glas Painter pen.



Mask off a section with painter's tape and wax paper. Dab molding paste around it with palette knife, leaving some color, then let dry. Spritz more Art Spray on top and blend with a brush. For extra distress, sand lightly. Remove wax paper and tape.



Trim piece to fit within the framed area on the wood panel. Adhere with Artist-Tac film. Seal the entire panel with a light acrylic finishing spray.
